

# Ely Stained Glass Museum

Awarded £24,497 under Measure 313 Encouragement of Tourism

The Fens Adventurers were delighted to support Ely's 'Bigger Picture' project to not only help conserve some very fine stained glass of historic and artistic importance but equally importantly to enable more of the collection to be put on display. Already the museum attracts over 17,000 visitors a year –and with the investment it is anticipated these figures will increase year on year.

The Stained Glass Museum has gradually become more widely known over its 30 year life –but it is apparent it still remains somewhat hidden and low profile. This investment is part of almost a £50,000 investment package which will support more flexible hanging systems, more conserved panels, better lighting and a better 'linked' web site to promote the Museum.

Sarah Robertson, The Curator said "The grant has enabled the Museum to conserve some very old stained glass and made it possible to build up our options for displaying more of our collection. The enhanced lighting and more easily managed frames will help us to ring the changes and put on a greater variety of displays. All of this, together with improved web based information and marketing, should result in more visitors and more local spend which has to be good".
