

Maximum Precision

Awarded £25,000 under Measure 312 : Micro enterprise creation

Fens Adventurers were very pleased to support Gareth Jones and James Butcher in the relocation and expansion of their



new engineering business Maximum Precision. The company offers precision engineering and manufacturing services, delivering turned and milled components for production and research and development.

Since beginning in 2009 the company grew rapidly and the need to expand and



purchase new machinery to cope with orders became a priority. Gareth and James secured a grant of just over £25,000 towards the cost of expansion and the purchase of a new lathe and CNC milling machine. This supported the start-up in breaking into higher value product areas and allowed the business to keep up with the high

demand for their services. The expansion of the business would have been significantly delayed without the grant support, limiting the range of services that the company could offer to clients.

Maximum Precision has been spectacularly successful with turnover increasing some 900% in 2011/12. Gareth and James said “with the help of the grant we’ve been able to create 5 full time jobs and push our business forward much quicker than we originally envisaged”.
