Warm Hubs in Child and Family Centres

Cambridgeshire County Council's Child and Family Centres offer groups, events, activities, courses and support for families with children aged 0-19. They offer such things as:

- Support groups run by family workers
- Information and advice about education and childcare
- Employment, training and benefits advice
- Drop-in play sessions
- Child development and special needs
- Parenting courses
- A meeting place for parents, carers and childminders
- Parent led sessions and groups
- Dads' groups
- Health services such as midwives and health visitor clinics

They also offer an alternative warm space for families to attend if their local Warm Hub is unavailable on a particular day. The Child and Family Centres listed below are affiliated to the Warm Hubs Cambridgeshire network. They provide a place to be warm, have a hot drink, play with the toys and meet others.
